

FRC Summer Bridge Program 2016

What is it?

The Summer Bridge Program is designed to help incoming students refresh their knowledge and get a head start before the semester begins. Students will participate in a two-week session with math, English, and college readiness workshops. Participation in the program is free! School supplies, lunch each day and fun local activities are also provided.

Bridge programs are designed to prepare students and ease the transition into college. Topics include general “college knowledge”, study skills, time management, learning styles, strategies for studying, expectations, and more! Academic content may include accelerated instruction in developmental math, reading and writing skills.

Who is it for?

Priority is given to new students who are one or more of the following: enrolled in basic skills classes, a first-generation college student, low-income, from Plumas County, eligible for DSPS services, foster youth, veterans, or other target populations identified in the college’s student equity plan as disproportionately impacted.

Students who are committed to their education and feel they would benefit from a refresher, or just want to get ahead are also encouraged to sign up.

When is it and Where?

Monday, August 8th -11th & August 15th -18th (Monday-Thursday) from 10:30 am to 1:00 pm

Workshops are held in Main 605 & 608 on the FRC Campus

Activities will also be available in the afternoons

Why should I go?

By participating, you may be able to jump ahead to a higher level English and/or math course which saves YOU time and money. Participants will meet new people and get better integrated with the college.

Summer Bridge will provide incoming students with the academic skills necessary to be successful in college. Students will develop relationships on campus with instructors, mentors, advisors, student ambassadors and other supportive members of the campus community.

If that’s not enough reason, there are more incentives! Attend all sessions and get up to \$400 in textbooks loaned to you for fall semester (conditional on funding and number of qualified students) also earn meal cards, calculators and other cool things!
